I. Setting for AppManager

1. Go to "Menu -> Settings"



2. Go to "Settings" -> "App. Manager"



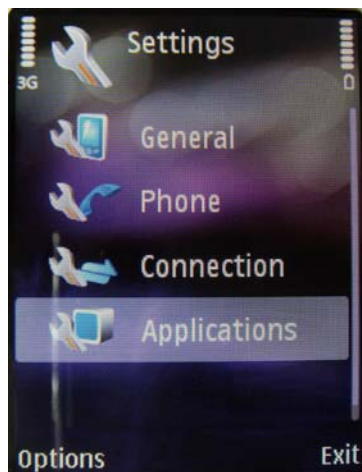
3. Go to **"Software Installation"** with All

II. Network Settings

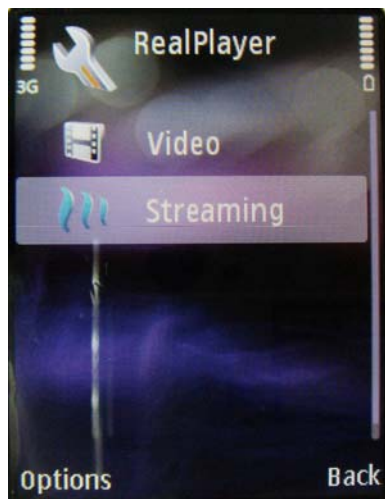
1. Go to **"Menu"** -> **"Settings"** -> **"Applications"**



2. Choose **"RealPlayer"**



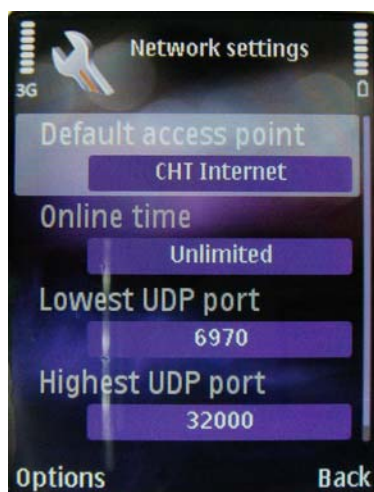
3. Choose "**Streaming**"

1. Go to "Menu -> Web"

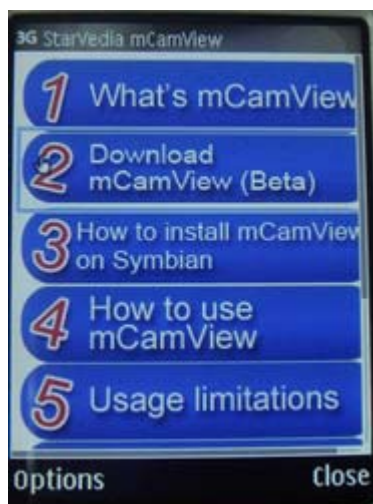


2. Adding bookmark –

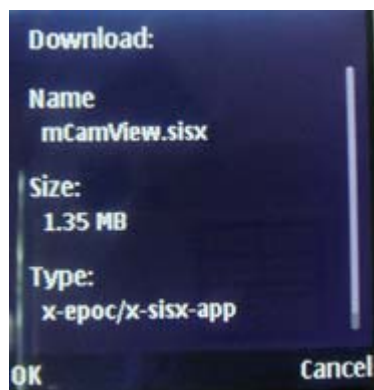


3. Download **mCamView (Beta)** to your phone.

Press OK

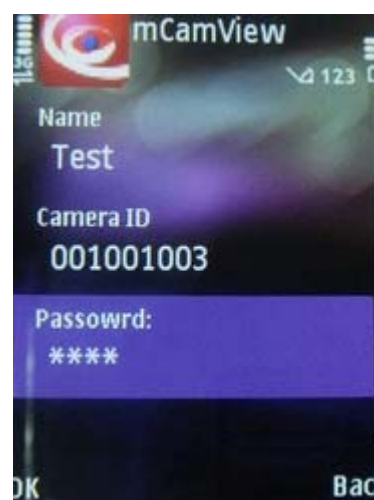
5. Menu -> **Applications** -> Run **mCamview**



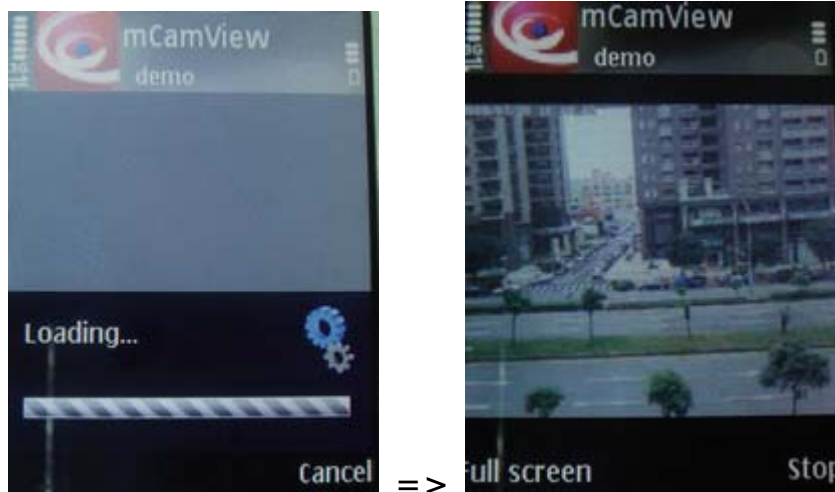

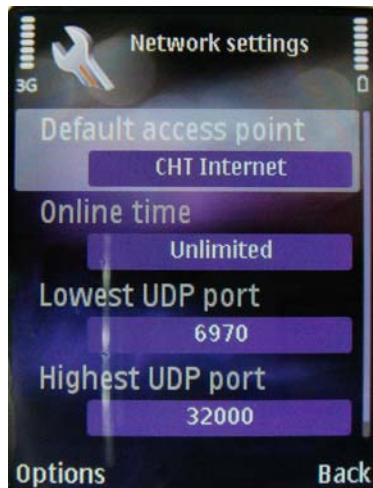
6. Run **mCamview** -> Menu -> Add -> Camera ID / Password
